AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to permitting a minor over twelve years of age to work as a referee for athletic games or competitions under certain circumstances

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 130 of the labor law is amended by 1 2 adding a new paragraph i to read as follows:

i. A minor over twelve years of age as a referee at an athletic game, 3 4 competition or tournament, involving competitors who are twelve years of 5 age or younger, hosted by an athletic association or organization that has trained and tested such minor in accordance with established safety б 7 standards, for a duration of twenty hours or less per week and during 8 times when school is not in session and the minor is accompanied by the 9 parent or quardian or has presented the written consent of the parent or 10 quardian.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
