AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to certain controlled substances offenses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 220.00 of the penal law is amended by adding a new
2 subdivision 21 to read as follows:

3 21. "Knowingly" when used in connection with the offenses involving
4 the possession or sale, or the attempt or conspiracy to possess or sell,
5 a synthetic cannabinoid, synthetic cathinone, or a controlled substance
6 analogue, shall not require knowledge by the defendant of the chemical
7 structure of the substance, but rather, it is sufficient if:

8 (a) the defendant knew or should have known that the substance has a
9 stimulant, depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous
10 system that is substantially similar to or greater than the stimulant,
11 depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous system of a
12 controlled substance in schedule I or II of section thirty-three hundred
13 six of the public health law; or

14 (b) the defendant represented or intended for the substance to have a
15 stimulant, depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous
16 system that is substantially similar to or greater than the stimulant,
17 depressant, or hallucinogenic effect on the central nervous system of a
18 controlled substance in schedule I or II of section thirty-three hundred
19 six of the public health law.

20 § 2. Subdivision 8 of section 220.06 of the penal law, as added by
21 chapter 264 of the laws of 2003, is amended and a new subdivision 9 is
22 added to read as follows:

23 8. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances
24 containing gamma hydroxybutyric acid, as defined in paragraph four of

subdivision (e) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law, and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of twenty-eight grams or more[~~+~~];

or

9. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a synthetic cannabinoid as defined in subdivision (g) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of one ounce or more.

§ 3. Subdivision 15 of section 220.09 of the penal law, as added by chapter 264 of the laws of 2003, is amended and a new subdivision 16 is added to read as follows:

15. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing gamma hydroxybutyric acid, as defined in paragraph four of subdivision (e) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law, and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of two hundred grams or more[~~+~~];

or

16. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a synthetic cannabinoid as defined in subdivision (g) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of four ounces or more.

§ 4. Subdivision 13 of section 220.16 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 75 of the laws of 1995, is amended and a new subdivision 14 is added to read as follows:

13. phencyclidine and said phencyclidine weighs one thousand two hundred fifty milligrams or more[~~+~~];

or

14. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a synthetic cannabinoid as defined in subdivision (g) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of ten pounds or more.

§ 5. Subdivision 3 of section 220.34 of the penal law, as amended by chapter 537 of the laws of 1998, is amended and a new subdivision 10 is added to read as follows:

3. concentrated cannabis as defined in [~~paragraph (a) of~~] subdivision four of section thirty-three hundred two of the public health law; or

10. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a synthetic cannabinoid as defined in subdivision (g) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of one ounce or more.

§ 6. Subdivision 9 of section 220.39 of the penal law, as added by chapter 410 of the laws of 1979, is amended and a new subdivision 10 is added to read as follows:

9. a narcotic preparation to a person less than twenty-one years old[~~+~~];

or

10. one or more preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances containing a synthetic cannabinoid as defined in subdivision (g) of schedule I of section thirty-three hundred six of the public health law and said preparations, compounds, mixtures or substances are of an aggregate weight of sixteen ounces or more.

§ 7. This act shall take effect November 1, 2018.
