AN ACT directing the president of the civil service commission to study and publish a report on nurse practitioners

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. It is the policy of this state to pursue equitable compensation for similar titles/duties within the state workforce and provide for opportunities for career advancement. Compensation should be based 4 not only on educational requirements, but also on the actual duties, 5 experience and advanced educational certification. The job title of 6 nurse practitioner is overdue for a thorough review by the civil service commission.
- § 2. The president of the state civil service commission is hereby 9 directed to study and publish a report on the job title of nurse practitioner. The study and report shall include, but not be limited to:
 - (a) the current job description of nurse practitioner and any changes that should be made to more accurately reflect the actual duties;
 - (b) determination if the current grade 24 adequately reflects the actual complexity of responsibilities and duties;
- 15 (c) the identification of a career ladder to be utilized in line with 16 other professionals such as registered nurses, social workers, rehabilitation counselors, dentists and doctors; and 17
- 18 (d) recognition of board certification as part of the career ladder.
- 19 § 3. The president of the civil service commission shall determine if 20 there is a need to make changes to the nurse practitioner title based on
