AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to cardiovascular technologists

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 3501 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 20 to read as follows:
- 20. "Cardiovascular technologist" means a person who is authorized to assist with diagnostic examinations and therapeutic interventions of the heart and blood vessels under the direct supervision of a physician, including invasive cardiology-cardiac catheterization, non-invasive cardiology, non-invasive peripheral vascular study, and cardiac electrophysiology.
- 9 § 2. The opening paragraph of subdivision 4 of section 3502 of the 10 public health law is designated paragraph (a) and a new paragraph (b) is 11 added to read as follows:
- 12 (b) Nothing in this article or in any other provision of law shall
 13 prevent a cardiovascular technologist, acting under the direct super14 vision of a physician, from introducing contrast medium to a patient
 15 during a cardiovascular diagnostic or interventional procedure through
- 16 <u>an arterial line placed by a licensed practitioner. The introduction of</u>
 17 <u>contrast medium in preparation of or during such procedures shall not</u>
- 18 constitute the administration of medication for the purposes of this
- 19 section.
- 20 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
