AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to driving slowly in a passing lane

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new
2 section 1132 to read as follows:

3 § 1132. Driving in passing lane. No motor vehicle shall drive in a
4 passing lane if they are not overtaking or passing a vehicle pursuant to
5 section one thousand one hundred twenty-two of this article, or if they
6 are going five miles or more under the designated speed limit. Any
7 person who violates this section shall be subject to a fine of up to
8 seventy-five dollars.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
