AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to driving slowly in a passing lane

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1132 to read as follows:

S 1132. Driving in passing lane. (a) No motor vehicle shall drive in a passing lane if they are not overtaking or passing a vehicle pursuant to section one thousand one hundred twenty-two of this article, or if they are going ten miles or more under the designated speed limit, except as follows:

- 8 <u>1. where required by any other section of law;</u>
- 9 <u>2. when an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive in a pass-</u> 10 <u>ing lane;</u>

11 <u>3. when approaching and passing an authorized emergency vehicle,</u>

12 hazard vehicle, or any other vehicle which is parked, stopped or stand-13 ing on a highway;

14 <u>4. when directed to by a traffic-control device, police officer or</u> 15 <u>flag person; and</u>

16 <u>5. when any special hazard exists with respect to pedestrians, other</u> 17 <u>traffic, weather or highway conditions.</u>

- 18 (b) Any person who violates this section shall be subject to a fine of 19 up to seventy-five dollars.
- 20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
