AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to commitment for intermittent sentences

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 430.20 of the criminal procedure law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 3-a to read as follows:

3 3-a. Transfer of commitment for intermittent sentences. Notwithstanding subdivision three of this section, where the defendant at the time
of intermittent sentencing resides in another jurisdiction within the
state, the sentencing court may transfer commitment to the county
correctional facility where the defendant resides with the consent of
the sheriffs of the county of the sentencing court and the county of the
residence of the defendant. The sentencing judge shall retain jurisdiction for additional matters pertaining to the case.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 12 have become a law.
