AN ACT to amend the public housing law, in relation to establishing a senior housing task force

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. The public housing law is amended by adding a new section
2	12-a to read as follows:
3	<u>§ 12-a. Senior housing task force. 1. There is hereby established</u>
4	within the division of housing and community renewal a senior housing
5	task force. It shall meet as often as necessary, but no less than four
б	times per year. All members shall be provided with notice reasonably in
7	advance of each meeting with date, time and location of such meeting.
8	Task force members may use videoconferencing for attendance and partic-
9	ipation. The task force shall consist of sixteen members and shall
10	include representatives from the following state agencies: the division
11	of housing and community renewal, the office for the aging, the depart-
12	ment of health, the office of mental health, the department of economic
13	development, the office for people with developmental disabilities, the
14	division of protective services for adults of the office of children and
15	family services, and the New York city department for the aging. Of the
16	eight remaining members, three shall be appointed by the speaker of the
17	assembly, three shall be appointed by the temporary president of the
18	senate, one shall be appointed by the minority leader of the assembly
19	and one shall be appointed by the minority leader of the senate, and
20	shall broadly represent housing and senior citizen groups from all
21	geographic areas of the state including service providers, associations,
22	advocates, proprietors, and consumers of for-profit and not-for-profit
23	senior housing options including but not limited to: assisted living
24	facilities, adult homes, skilled nursing facilities, independent living
25	facilities, naturally occurring retirement communities, neighborhood

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naturally occurring retirement communities, and continuing care retire-1 ment communities. Members shall receive no compensation for their 2 3 services but shall be reimbursed for travel and other expenses actually 4 and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties. The task 5 force shall be co-chaired by the commissioner of the division of housing б and community renewal and the director of the office for the aging. The 7 task force is responsible for conducting an annual state-wide assessment 8 of senior housing needs taking into consideration the various geograph-9 ical areas and different needs of the seniors in those areas and 10 resources available in those different areas and project those needs 11 over the next five years; other factors which shall be taken into consideration are: health care needs of seniors, the long term care 12 needs of seniors, financial resources available to seniors, or needed by 13 14 seniors, and transportation needs of seniors. The assessment shall include, but not be limited to, a review of innovative approaches 15 16 successfully being implemented in New York state and in other states and 17 their potential for implementation or expansion in this state. Such assessment shall also develop a plan for providing quality senior hous-18 ing to meet the projected needs of seniors located in different 19 20 geographical areas of the state. 21 2. The task force shall issue a report by each January first outlining 22 its findings, recommendations, and the state plan. The report shall be delivered to the governor, the speaker of the assembly, the temporary 23 president of the senate, the chairpersons of the housing, aging and 24

25 <u>health committees in the assembly, and the chairpersons of the housing,</u> 26 <u>construction and community development, aging and health committees in</u>

27 the senate.

28 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 29 have become a law.
