AN ACT to amend the executive law, in relation to regulatory fines for small businesses

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 170-c 2 to read as follows:

 3 **§ 170-c.** Regulatory fines for small businesses. 1. Notwithstanding
- 4 any other law, rule or regulation to the contrary, no state agency shall 5 fine a small business for a first violation of such agency's regu-

- 6 <u>lations</u>. <u>Upon such first violation</u>, <u>a state agency shall (a) provide</u>
- 7 <u>literature detailing the agency's regulations to such small business, or</u>

- 10 2. "Small business" as used in this section shall mean a business
- 11 which is resident in this state, independently owned and operated, not
