AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to a stay of the enforcement of a determination involving a permit or approval in connection with the development or construction of residential housing

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 7805 of the civil practice law and rules is amended to read as follows:

§ 7805. Stay. On the motion of any party or on its own initiative, the 4 court may stay further proceedings, or the enforcement of any determi-5 nation under review, upon terms including notice, security and payment 6 of costs, except that the enforcement of an order or judgment granted by the appellate division in a proceeding under this article may be stayed 8 only by order of the appellate division or the court of appeals. Unless 9 otherwise ordered, security given on a stay is effective in favor of a 10 person subsequently joined as a party under section 7802 of this The court in issuing a stay of the enforcement of a determi-11 <u>article</u>. 12 nation involving a permit or approval in connection with the development 13 or construction of residential housing may, upon the filing of a peti-14 tion by the respondent, require the posting of security bond in an 15 amount the court shall deem proper.

16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
