AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to contracts for the Arthur O. Eve opportunity for higher education

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Paragraphs g and h of subdivision 3 of section 6451 of the education law, as added by chapter 494 of the laws of 2016, are amended and two new paragraphs i and j are added to read as follows:
- 4 g. Expenses related to helping students apply for and prepare for 5 graduate or professional school; [and]
- 6 h. The hiring of enrolled students participating in an Arthur O. Eve 7 opportunity for higher education work-study program [-];
  - i. The hiring of clerical support staff; and

- 9 j. Professional development activities and travel for program staff.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and the same manner 11 as chapter 494 of the laws of 2016, takes effect.
