AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to reimbursement methodologies for tuition

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph a of subdivision 4 of section 4405 of the educa-  
2 tion law, as amended by chapter 53 of the laws of 1990, is amended to  
3 read as follows:  
4 a. The commissioner [~~of education~~] and the commissioner of social  
5 services shall develop reimbursement methodologies for the tuition and  
6 maintenance components of approved private schools and special act  
7 school districts. The commissioner [~~of education~~], in consultation with  
8 the appropriate state agencies and departments, shall have responsibil-  
9 ity for developing [~~a~~] reimbursement [~~methodology~~] methodologies for  
10 tuition which shall be based upon appropriate educational standards  
11 promulgated pursuant to regulations of the commissioner [~~of education~~].  
12 The commissioner of social services, in consultation with appropriate  
13 state agencies and departments, shall have responsibility for developing  
14 [~~a~~] reimbursement [~~methodology~~] methodologies for maintenance, pursuant  
15 to section three hundred ninety-eight-a of the social services law and  
16 the regulations promulgated thereunder.  
17 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
