AN ACT to amend the real property law, in relation to the recording of a transfer or assignment of a mortgage interest

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The real property law is amended by adding a new section 291-k to read as follows:

  Section 291-k. Recording of transfers and assignments of mortgages; mortgage ownership assignment document. 1. A recording officer shall not record or accept for recording any mortgage or assignment of mortgage made by a non-natural person affecting land in this state unless accompanied by a mortgage ownership assignment document in a form prescribed by this section and the fee prescribed pursuant to section eight thousand twenty-one of the civil practice law and rules. Such form shall be recorded no later than ninety days after the date of the acknowledgment or proof of such instrument.

Failure to record a mortgage or assignment of mortgage made by a non-natural person affecting land in this state by the date specified in subdivision one of this section, shall subject the mortgagee or assignee who fails to comply with this section to a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars. The penalty shall be assessed by, and payable to, the recording officer. Penalties collected pursuant to this subdivision shall be used to support recording officer operations.
