AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to duties of certain parole officers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 10 of the correction law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 5 to read as follows:

5. Duties to be performed exclusively by parole officers shall include, but not be limited to: executing parole warrants, transporting parolees, conducting substance abuse testing of parolees, conducting home or field visits with parolees, conducting any investigation relating to parolees violating the terms and conditions of their release, or any matter specifically related to parolee supervision. Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed to prevent an officer not employed by the department and authorized to execute a parole warrant pursuant to subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subdivision three of section two hundred fifty-nine-i of the executive law from executing such parole warrant.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
