AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to theft of transit services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 165.18 to 2 read as follows:

§ 165.18 Theft of transit services. A person is quilty of theft of transit services when:

1. with intent to obtain railroad or subway service without payment of 6 the lawful charge therefor, or to avoid payment of the lawful charge for such transportation service which has been rendered to him or her, he or she obtains or attempts to obtain such service or avoids or attempts to avoid payment therefor by force, intimidation, stealth, deception or mechanical tampering, or by unjustifiable failure or refusal to pay; or

2. with intent to obtain bus, air, taxi or any other public transpor-12 tation service without payment of the lawful charge therefor, or to avoid payment of the lawful charge for such transportation service which
