AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to the sale of privately held wines and liquors

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 2 of section 99-g of the alcoholic beverage control law, as amended by chapter 445 of the laws of 2012, is amended to read as follows:

4 (b) A wine and liquor auction permit shall be issued for a calendar
5 year. A wine and liquor auction permit shall allow the holder to conduct
6 [twenty-four] forty-eight auctions of wine and/or liquor during the
7 period the wine and liquor auction permit shall be in effect.
8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
