AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to labeling requirements for electric assisted bicycles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 399-qqq to read as follows:

- § 399-ggg. Labeling of electric assisted bicycles. 1. No person, firm, 4 or corporation shall sell or offer for sale any electric assisted bicycle unless there is printed on the package in which such electric assisted bicycle is sold or offered for sale a conspicuous notice stating that the operation of such electric assisted bicycle on any public highway or sidewalk is prohibited.
- 9 2. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the 10 <u>following meanings:</u>
- 11 (a) "Public highway" shall have the same meaning as defined in section 12 one hundred thirty-four of the vehicle and traffic law.
- 13 (b) "Sidewalk" shall have the same meaning as defined in section one 14 <u>hundred forty-four of the vehicle and traffic law.</u>
- 15 (c) "Electric assisted bicycle" shall mean a bicycle with two or three 16 wheels which has a saddle and fully operative pedals for human propulsion and also has an electric motor. The electric assisted bicycle's 17 electric motor shall: have a power output of less than seven hundred 18 19 fifty watts; have a maximum speed of less than twenty miles per hour on 20 a paved level surface when powered solely by such a motor while ridden 21 by an operator who weighs one hundred seventy pounds; and be incapable 22 of further increasing the speed of the device when human power is used
- to propel the device at or more than twenty miles per hour. 23
- 24 3. Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a civil penal-25 ty not to exceed five hundred dollars.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
