AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to relevant market areas

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 15 of section 462 of the vehicle and traffic 2 law, as added by chapter 490 of the laws of 2008, is amended to read as follows:

15. "Relevant market area" means:

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- (a) if the proposed additional or relocated motor vehicle dealer is to be located in a county having a population in excess of one hundred thousand, the area within the radius of six miles of the intended site 7 of the proposed or relocated dealer. Such six mile distance shall be 9 determined by measuring the distance between the nearest surveyed boundary of the existing new motor vehicle dealer's principal place of busi-10 11 ness and the nearest surveyed boundary line of the proposed or relocated 12 new motor vehicle dealer's place of business. In the event this radius 13 crosses the Hudson river, then the distance shall be determined by meas-14 uring the driving distance between the nearest surveyed boundary of the 15 existing new motor vehicle dealer's principal place of business and the 16 nearest surveyed boundary line of the proposed or relocated new motor 17 vehicle dealer's place of business; or
- (b) if the proposed additional or relocated motor vehicle dealer is to be within a county having a population of less than one hundred thousand, the area within the radius of ten miles of the intended site of the proposed or relocated dealer. Such ten mile distance shall be deter-22 mined by measuring the distance between the nearest surveyed boundary line of the existing new motor vehicle dealer's principal place of busi-24 ness and the nearest surveyed boundary line of the proposed or relocated 25 new motor vehicle dealer's principal place of business. 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this radius crosses the Hudson river, then the distance shall be determined by measuring the driving distance between the nearest surveyed boundary of the existing new motor vehicle dealer's principal place of business and the nearest surveyed boundary line of the proposed or relocated new motor vehicle dealer's place of business.

In determining the population of a county, the most recent census by the U.S. Bureau of Census or the most recent population update, either from the National Planning Data Corporation or other similar recognized source, shall be used.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
