AN ACT to require the office for people with developmental disabilities to establish the care demonstration program; to monitor and report on the effectiveness thereof; and to repeal certain provisions of such law relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. (a) The commissioner of the office for people with develop-2 mental disabilities shall establish the care demonstration program, to utilize the state workforce to provide community based care to individuals with developmental disabilities.

- 5 (b) The services provided by these pilots shall include, but shall not 6 be limited to:
 - (i) community habilitation;
 - (ii) in-home respite;
 - (iii) pathways to employment;
- 10 (iv) supported employment (SEMP); and
- 11 (v) community prevocational services.
- 12 § 2. The office for people with developmental disabilities shall monitor the quality and effectiveness of the demonstration programs, and shall report such results to the governor, the temporary president of
- the senate, and the speaker of the assembly, no later than December 31, 15 16 2020.

- § 3. The commissioner of the office for people with disabilities shall 17 18 promulgate all rules and regulations necessary to implement the 19 provisions of this section.
- § 4. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire and be 20 21 deemed repealed March 31, 2021; provided however, that all rules and 22 regulations necessary for the implementation of this act shall have been
- 23 promulgated prior to such effective date.
