AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the assault of a driver of a for-hire vehicle

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as  
2 separately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 11. With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket  
5 inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station  
6 cleaner or terminal cleaner employed by any transit agency, authority or  
7 company, public or private, whose operation is authorized by New York  
8 state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal, a school  
9 crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the  
10 general municipal law, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforce-  
11 ment agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section  
12 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement agent, New  
13 York city sanitation worker, public health sanitarian, New York city  
14 public health sanitarian, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse,  
15 emergency medical service paramedic, [~~or~~] emergency medical service  
16 technician or driver of a for-hire vehicle as defined in paragraph (b)  
17 of subdivision two of section 60.07 of this chapter, he or she causes  
18 physical injury to such train operator, ticket inspector, conductor,  
19 signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station cleaner or terminal  
20 cleaner, city marshal, school crossing guard appointed pursuant to  
21 section two hundred eight-a of the general municipal law, traffic  
22 enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in  
23 subdivision thirty-one of section 1.20 of the criminal procedure law,
