AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the assault of a driver of a for-hire vehicle or transportation network company driver

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 11 of section 120.05 of the penal law, as 2 separately amended by chapters 268 and 281 of the laws of 2016, is 3 amended to read as follows:

11. With intent to cause physical injury to a train operator, ticket inspector, conductor, signalperson, bus operator, station agent, station 6 cleaner or terminal cleaner employed by any transit agency, authority or 7 company, public or private, whose operation is authorized by New York state or any of its political subdivisions, a city marshal, a school crossing guard appointed pursuant to section two hundred eight-a of the 10 general municipal law, a traffic enforcement officer, traffic enforcement agent, prosecutor as defined in subdivision thirty-one of section 11 1.20 of the criminal procedure law, sanitation enforcement agent, New 12 York city sanitation worker, public health sanitarian, New York city 13 public health sanitarian, registered nurse, licensed practical nurse, 14 emergency medical service paramedic, [ex] emergency medical service 16 technician, driver of a for-hire vehicle as defined in paragraph (b) of subdivision two of section 60.07 of this chapter or transportation 17 18 network company driver as defined in subdivision four of section sixteen 19 <u>hundred ninety-one of the vehicle and traffic law</u>, he or she causes 20 physical injury to such train operator, ticket inspector, conductor,
