AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to authorizing the waiver of citizenship requirements for certain police and firefighters

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new subdivision 1-b to read as follows:

1-b. Citizenship requirements of police and/or firefighters. Notwithstanding any general, special or local law or administrative code to the
contrary, the local governing bodies of the several cities, counties,
towns, villages, police and fire districts of the state are hereby
authorized to waive any citizenship requirements from the qualifications
of police officers and/or firefighters upon the submission by the police
officer or firefighter candidate of proof of:

- 10 (a) having received an honorable or general discharge from the United
  11 States army, navy, air force, marines, coast guard, and/or reserves
  12 thereof, and/or the army national guard, air national guard, New York
  13 guard and/or New York naval militia; and
- 14 (b) having never been convicted of a crime, as defined in subdivision 15 six of section 10.00 of the penal law.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
