AN ACT to establish the New York state 2020 complete count commission and providing for its powers and duties

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Commission established. (a) A commission to be known as the 1 2 New York state 2020 complete count commission, hereafter referred to as 3 the commission, is hereby established to identify issues that may have 4 led to past United States census undercounts in New York state and to make recommendations to ensure an accurate count in the 2020 United 5 б States census. 7 (b) The commission shall consist of sixteen members to be appointed as 8 follows: 9 (i) four members, including the chair and co-chair, shall be appointed 10 by the governor from executive agencies and organizations that have significant interaction with the general public; 11 12 (ii) two members shall be appointed by the governor from agencies of 13 the city of New York that have significant interaction with the general 14 public; (iii) two members shall be appointed by the governor representing 15 interests of regions outside of the city of New York; 16 (iv) three members shall be appointed by the speaker of the assembly; 17 (v) one member shall be appointed by the minority leader of the assem-18 19 bly; 20 (vi) three members shall be appointed by the temporary president of 21 the senate; and 22 (vii) one member appointed by the minority leader of the senate. 23 (c) The appointments made pursuant to this act shall, to the extent 24 practicable, reflect the diversity of the residents of this state with

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1 regard to race, ethnicity, gender, language, age, and geographic resi-2 dence and, to the extent practicable the appointing authorities shall, in considering potential appointees to the commission, consult with 3 organizations devoted to representing municipalities and educational 4 5 institutions, and organizations providing services to the elderly, chilб dren, minority communities, and individuals and communities to combat 7 poverty. 8 (d) The members of the commission shall receive no compensation for 9 their services as members, but shall be reimbursed for their actual and 10 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. 11 (e) Notwithstanding any inconsistent provision of any general, special local law, ordinance, resolution or charter, no officer, member or 12 or 13 employee of the state or of any public corporation shall forfeit his or 14 her office or employment by reason of his or her acceptance of appoint-15 ment as a member of the commission, nor shall service as such commission 16 member be deemed incompatible or in conflict with such office or employ-17 ment. 18 (f) The commission may appoint such staff as may be necessary to carry out its duties. Such staff shall receive no compensation for their 19 20 services but shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses 21 incurred by them in the performance of the commission's duties. 22 2. Powers and duties of the commission. (a) The commission shall § 23 study, examine and review the issues that may have led to past United States census undercounts in New York state and shall make recommenda-24 25 tions to ensure an accurate count in the 2020 United States census. 26 (b) The commission may meet and hold public hearings and events within 27 the state. 28 (c) The commission may establish committees and workgroups in further-29 ance of the purposes set forth in this act, and may include on such 30 committees and workgroups individuals who are not members of the commis-31 sion. 32 (d) The commission may request and shall receive from any subdivision, 33 department, board, commission, office, agency, or other instrumentality of the state or of any political subdivision thereof such facilities, 34 35 assistance and data reasonably available as it deems necessary or desir-36 able for the proper execution of its powers and duties and to effectuate 37 the purposes set forth in this act. 38 (e) The commission is authorized and empowered to enter into any 39 agreements and to do and perform any acts that may be necessary, desirable or proper to carry out the purposes and objectives of this act, 40 including entering into contracts in furtherance of the provisions of 41 42 this act. (f) On or before March 1, 2018, the commission shall transmit to 43 the 44 governor and the legislature a report containing an overview of the issues that may have led to past United States census undercounts in New 45 46 York state and a comprehensive action plan for state and local govern-47 mental and non-governmental agencies to work together to ensure an accurate count in the 2020 United States census. Such report shall also 48 include recommendations on state funds for the next two ensuing fiscal 49 years necessary to ensure an accurate count in the 2020 United States 50 51 census. (g) On or before March 1, 2019, the commission shall transmit to the 52 53 governor and the Legislature a report detailing the actions taken by the 54 commission since the initial report, and detail how any appropriations 55 made for the 2019-2020 fiscal year will be used to meet the recommendations and action plan made in the commission's initial report, and 56

1 include any recommended changes to its previous recommendations on state 2 funds necessary to ensure an accurate count in the 2020 United States 3 census.

4 (h) On or before November 1, 2019, the commission shall transmit to 5 the governor and the legislature a final report detailing the actions 6 taken by the commission since the previous report, and detail how any 7 appropriations made have been and will be used to ensure an accurate 8 count in the 2020 United States census. The report shall also include 9 any recommended additional state funds necessary to meet the recommenda-10 tions and action plan made in the commission's initial report.

(i) The performance of the commission's duties, purposes and objectives shall be executed within amounts made available by appropriation therefor.

14 (j) The commission shall continue in existence until December 31, 15 2020.

16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
