AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to enacting the "construction safety course accountability act"

### The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "construction safety course accountability act".

3 § 2. Section 220-h of the labor law, as added by chapter 282 of the 4 laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:

Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) 5 S 220-h. construction safety and health course. 1. The advertised specifications б 7 for every contract for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance 8 and/or repair of public work to which the state or a municipality is a party, where the total cost of all work to be performed under the 9 10 contract is at least two hundred fifty thousand dollars, shall contain a provision requiring that all laborers, workers, and mechanics employed 11 in the performance of the contract on the public work site, either by 12 13 the contractor, sub-contractor or other person doing or contracting to do the whole or a part of the work contemplated by the contract, shall 14 15 be certified prior to performing any work on the project as having successfully completed a course in construction safety and health 16 approved by the United States department of labor's occupational safety 17 and health administration that is at least ten hours in duration. 18

The department shall license any entity or organization in the 20 state which offers a course to laborers, workers, and mechanics in 21 construction safety and health approved by the United States Department 22 of Labor's occupational safety and health administration that is at 23 least ten hours in duration, including, but not limited to courses given 24 in order that such laborers, workers and mechanics may be eligible to
