AN ACT to amend the general obligations law, in relation to rights of certain airline passengers

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general obligations law is amended by adding a new article 14 to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 14

## RIGHTS OF CERTAIN AIRLINE PASSENGERS

- § 14-101. Rights of certain airline passengers. Any airline that provides departures from airports located within this state shall offer compensation in accordance with this section to ticketed passengers who voluntarily relinquish their seats on flights that are overbooked, upon 10 the request of airline personnel. Such compensation shall be in addition to rebooking such passenger on another flight to the same final destination. Any ticketed passenger who has voluntarily relinquished his or her seat as provided in this section shall be entitled to minimum monetary 14 compensation from the airline as follows:
- 15 (a) Such minimum monetary compensation shall initially be made at a 16 rate of fifty percent of the average value of a comparable ticket for 17 <u>the overbooked flight;</u>
- (b) The airline shall increase the amount of monetary compensation 18 offered by twenty percent of the original offer rounded to the nearest 19 20 whole number until an adequate number of passengers have voluntarily 21 relinquished their seats for that flight;
- 22 (c) Any ticketed passenger who has voluntarily relinquished his or her 23 shall be entitled to the same compensation, which shall be set at 24 the highest amount offered to any passenger for that flight;
