AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to permanent total disability

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 15 of the workers' compensation law, as amended by chapter 675 of the laws of 1977, is amended to read as follows:

3 4 1. Permanent total disability. In case of total disability adjudged to be permanent sixty-six and two-thirds per centum of the average weekly wages shall be paid to the employee during the continuance of such total 7 disability. Loss of both hands, or both arms, or both feet, or both legs, or both eyes, or of any two thereof or approval for federal social 9 security disability benefits as a result of the compensable accident or 10 occupational disease shall, in the absence of conclusive proof to the 11 contrary, constitute permanent total disability. In all other cases permanent total disability shall be determined in accordance with the 12 facts. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, an injured 13 employee disabled due to the loss or total loss of use of both eyes, or 14 15 both hands, or both arms, or both feet, or both legs, or of any two thereof shall not suffer any diminution of his or her compensation by 17 engaging in business or employment provided his or her earnings or 18 wages, when combined with his <u>or her</u> compensation, shall not be in 19 excess of the wage base on which the maximum weekly compensation benefit 20 is computed under the law in effect at time of such earning; further 21 provided, that if the combination exceeds such wage base, the compen-

sation shall be diminished to an amount which, together with his <u>or her</u> earnings or wages, shall equal the wage base; and further provided that the application of this subdivision shall not result in reduction of compensation which an injured employee who is disabled due to the loss or total loss of use of both eyes, or both hands, or both arms, or both feet, or both legs or of any two thereof, would otherwise be entitled to under any other provision of this section.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
