AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to providing for retroactivity to an original date of eligibility for the senior citizens rent increase exemption (SCRIE) and disability rent increase expiration (DRIE)

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "senior citizens rent increase exemption (SCRIE) and disability rent increase 3 exemption (DRIE) rollback act".
- § 2. Section 26-605 of the administrative code of the city of New York 5 is amended by adding a new subdivision (c-1) to read as follows:
- (c-1) For any eligible head of household who failed to make timely 7 application for a rent increase exemption order pursuant to subdivisions
- 8 (a) and (b) of this section, such application shall be deemed to have
- 9 occurred on the original date of eligibility for a rent increase 10 exemption order and rent reduction is retroactive to the original date
- 11 of eligibility; provided, however, that such rent reduction shall not be
- 12 retroactively applied to any period of eligibility that occurred prior
- 13 to the two-year period immediately preceding the filing of an applica-
- 14 tion for a rent increase exemption order.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
