AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to half-day shifts for election inspectors or poll clerks

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 3-400 of the election law, as 2 added by chapter 5 of the laws of 2010, is amended to read as follows:

- 7. The board of elections may employ election inspectors or poll 4 clerks to work half-day shifts with adjusted compensation, provided, 5 however, that there shall not be a time when the poll site is open that 6 there is not at least one inspector from each of the two major political parties [is] present [at the poll gite for the entire time that the polls are open]. Each county board of elections shall prescribe the 9 necessary rules and procedures to ensure proper poll site operation. 10 including rules detailing the basis on which a request by an election 11 inspector or poll clerk to work a half-day shift may be denied.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
