AN ACT to amend the workers' compensation law, in relation to liability for compensation

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subdivision 3 of section 10 of the work ers' compensation law, as added by section 1 of subpart I of part NNN of chapter 59 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows: (b) Where a police officer or firefighter subject to section thirty of this article, or emergency medical technician, paramedic, or other

6 person certified to provide medical certifician, parametric, of other 7 dispatcher or correction officer, sergeant, captain, corporal, lieuten-8 ant, deputy warden or warden employed by the New York state department 9 of corrections and community supervision, the department of correction 10 of the city of New York or any county or municipality files a claim for 11 mental injury premised upon extraordinary work-related stress incurred 12 in a work-related emergency, the board may not disallow the claim, upon 13 a factual finding that the stress was not greater than that which usual-14 ly occurs in the normal work environment.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
