AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to school energy efficiency collaboration programs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 1 and 2 of section 1882 of the public authori-2 ties law, as added by chapter 403 of the laws of 2016, are amended to 3 read as follows:

- 1. The purpose of the school energy collaborative program shall be to reduce redundancies, raise awareness and promote the efficient implementation of [public] school energy projects across New York state.
- 2. In developing this multidisciplinary collaborative program, the authority shall work in partnership with the New York power authority[7]; the Long Island power authority[7]; the state education department, including the office of religious and independent schools; the New York association of school business officials[7]; the New York state school boards association[7]; energy service companies[7]; utility programs and other school administrators.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
