AN ACT to amend the insurance law, in relation to limiting the provision of charitable bail to defendants who are first time offenders

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subsection (b) of section 6805 of the insurance law, as added by chapter 181 of the laws of 2012, is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 (1) only deposit money as bail in the amount of two thousand dollars
4 or less for a defendant charged with one or more misdemeanors committed
5 during a single occurrence or transaction, and who has never previously
6 been charged with a crime, provided, however, that such organization
7 shall not execute as surety any bond for any defendant;

8 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
