AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of unlawful broadcast of criminal activity

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding two new sections 245.15 and 245.20 to read as follows:
- 3 § 245.15 Unlawful broadcast of criminal activity in the second degree.
- 1. A person is guilty of unlawful broadcast of criminal activity in the second degree when he or she, during the commission of any acts constituting any felony offense, or acting as an accomplice to such offense, or acting as an agent to the person who commits such offense, broadcasts or causes to be broadcast or disseminated live video of such

- 12 (a) "Broadcast" means electronically transmitting a visual image with 13 the intent that it be viewed by a person.
