AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to sanctions for driving while ability impaired while holding a conditional license

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Clause d of subparagraph 7 of paragraph (e) of subdivision 2 of section 1193 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 251 of the laws of 2007, is amended to read as follows:

- d. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of this chapter, if any suspension occurring under this subparagraph has been in effect for a period of thirty days, [the holder may be issued] the department may, with the consent of the court, issue a conditional license, in accordance ance with section eleven hundred ninety-six of this article, provided the holder of such license is otherwise eligible to receive such conditional license. A conditional license issued pursuant to this subparagraph shall not be valid for the operation of a commercial motor vehicle. The commissioner shall prescribe by regulation the procedures for the issuance of such conditional license.
- 14 § 2. This act shall take effect one year after it shall have become a 15 law.
