- AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to permitting the use of recyclable beverage container packaging

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 27-1011 of the environmental 2 conservation law, as amended by section 7 of part SS of chapter 59 of 3 the laws of 2009, is amended to read as follows:

3. No deposit initiator, distributor or dealer shall sell or offer for sale in this state beverage containers connected to each other by a separate holding device constructed of plastic [which does not decompose], unless such device decomposes by photodegradation or biodegradation or such device is recyclable, made of at least ninety percent postconsumer recycled high density polyethylene, and does not have any holes greater than one and three-quarters inches in diameter.

11 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
