AN ACT to enact "Michelle and Jordan's law"; and to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to speed contests and races

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as "Michelle and Jordan's law".

- § 2. Subdivision 2 of section 1182 of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 9 of part C of chapter 62 of the laws of 2003, is amended to read as follows:
- 2. A second conviction within twelve months of a violation of this section shall constitute a class E felony and shall be punishable by imprisonment of [not more than six months] up to one year and one day or a fine of not less than five hundred twenty-five dollars nor more than seven hundred fifty dollars, or both such fine and imprisonment. 10
- § 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately the commissioner of 13 motor vehicles may add, amend, or repeal any rule or regulation neces-14 sary for the timely implementation of this act on its effective date.
