AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to establishing a maximum temperature in school buildings and indoor facilities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 409-m 2 to read as follows: 3 § 409-m. Maximum temperatures in school buildings and facilities. All 4 common, union free, central, central high schools, city school districts 5 and boards of cooperative educational services shall develop a policy 6 for ensuring the health and safety of students and faculty on extreme heat condition days. For the purpose of this section, extreme heat 7 8 condition days shall be defined as days when the occupiable educational 9 spaces are found to be ninety degrees Fahrenheit or greater. For the 10 purpose of this section, room temperature shall be measured at a shaded 11 location, three feet above the floor near the center of the room. § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after 12

13 it shall have become a law.
