AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to the calculation of the shelter allowance for persons and families residing in housing subsidized under section 8 of the United States housing act of 1937

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 131-a of the social services law is amended by adding a new paragraph (c-1) to read as follows:
- 4 law or regulation to the contrary, the shelter allowance for a person or
- 5 <u>family receiving federal low-income housing assistance pursuant to</u>
- 6 section 8 of the United States housing act of 1937 (42 U.S.C. § 1437f),
- 7 as amended, shall be the maximum shelter allowance prescribed by regu-
- 8 lations of the department.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 2018.
