AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring online market places to provide a product recall search web form

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 349-f to read as follows:

- § 349-f. Product recall search web form. 1. For purposes of this 4 section, the term "online market place" shall mean a type of e-commerce site where product service information is provided by multiple third parties, whereas transactions are processed by the market place operator. Online market places shall include, but shall not be limited to, Amazon, e-Bay and Craigslist.
- 9 2. Online market places shall provide on their web page, where a sell-10 er inputs product information, a web form where the seller may search 11 the United States consumer protection safety commission's recall central database. Online market places shall use the application program inter-12 13 face provided by the consumer protection safety commission's recall 14 retrieval web service to create such web form.
- 15 3. If it is determined through a search of the recall central data-16 base, as described in subdivision two of this section, that a product has been recalled, the online market place may block the seller of the 17 18 product from selling such product on their site.
- 19 4. The online market place shall also provide space on the web form, 20 described in subdivision two of this section, where sellers may indicate that they do not have enough information to determine if their product 22 has been recalled. The following shall be stated in such space: "I do not have enough information to determine if the product has been 23 24 recalled. I have read the related guidelines regarding selling recalled 25 products and I understand my responsibility to not sell a recalled prod-26 uct."
- § 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 27
