## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 5 of chapter 589 of the laws of 2015, amending the insurance law relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to 3 certain small groups, as amended by chapter 12 of the laws of 2016, is amended to read as follows:
- § 5. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same 6 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2015 amending the insurance law relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to certain small 8 groups, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S.5928-A and A.8134-A, takes effect and shall be deemed repealed [three] four years thereafter.
- 10 § 2. Section 5 of chapter 588 of the laws of 2015, amending the insur-11 ance law relating to catastrophic or reinsurance coverage issued to certain small groups, as amended by chapter 12 of the laws of 2016, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13
- § 5. This act shall take effect immediately; and shall be deemed 14 15 repealed [3] 4 years after it shall have become a law.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
