AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to the use of insect repellent by a child attending summer camp

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1394 of the public health law is amended by adding 2 a new subdivision 5 to read as follows:

5. Each children's overnight camp, summer day camp and traveling 4 summer day camp shall allow children attending such camp to carry and use insect repellent with the written permission of a parent or guardian of any child. A record of such permission shall be maintained by the camp. A child who is unable to physically apply insect repellent may be assisted by unlicensed personnel when directed to do so by the child, if permitted by a parent or quardian and authorized by the camp.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
