AN ACT to amend the mental hygiene law, in relation to reviewing suicide prevention programs periodically

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 7.07 of mental hygiene law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision (g) to read as follows:

(q) The office shall periodically review suicide prevention programs established by the office to ensure that the needs of individuals at 5 risk of suicide are being met and make recommendations to improve such 6 programs, which shall include but not be limited to: (1) cultural and linguistic competency; and (2) best practices for screening and inter-8 ventions aimed at addressing suicide risk factors for minority groups and other underrepresented populations.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
