AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring persons applying for a certificate or license to be a teacher to receive a passing score on the academic literacy skills test and the teacher performance assessment

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3004 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 1-b to read as follows:

1-b. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the commissioner 4 shall require all persons applying, on or after January first, two thousand eighteen, for a certificate or license to be a teacher, in addition to all the other certification or licensure requirements, to receive a passing score on the academic literacy skills test and the teacher performance assessment. The commissioner shall not provide a multiple measures review process, any equivalency measures or any safety net 10 measures in lieu of securing a passing score on the academic literacy skills test or the teacher performance assessment.

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- § 2. Any regulation providing a multiple measures review process, any 13 equivalency measures, or any safety net measures for applicants who fail 14 to achieve a passing score on the academic literacy skills test or the teacher performance assessment are null and void.
- § 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided, however, that 16 17 section one of this act shall be deemed to have been in full force and 18 effect on or after March 13, 2017.
