AN ACT to amend the real property tax law, in relation to requiring assessors of real property in the city of Albany to obtain commissioner of taxation and finance certification of successful completion of the basic course of training and education

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 334 of the real property tax law is amended by
2 adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:

3 4. Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision two of this section,
4 subdivision five of section three hundred ten of this title shall apply
5 to the city of Albany on and after January first, two thousand nineteen,
6 provided that an assessor whose term commenced prior to January first,
7 two thousand nineteen shall have until January first, two thousand twen-
8 ty-one to complete requirements of paragraph (a) of such subdivision
9 five.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
