AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to prohibiting sexual harassment by certain individuals

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 74 of the public officers law is 2 amended by adding a new paragraph j to read as follows:

3 j. No officer or employee of a state agency, member of the legislature 4 or legislative employee shall commit an act of sexual harassment while 5 serving in his or her official capacity. For purposes of this section, "sexual harassment" shall mean making unwelcome or unwanted sexual advances, requesting sexual favors in exchange for favorable treatment 7 or continued employment, engaging in verbal or physical conduct of a 9 sexual nature which is made a term or condition or employment, or using 10 the refusal or acceptance of such advances as the basis for employment 11 decisions. "Sexual harassment" shall also include any type of sexually 12 <u>oriented conduct that is unwelcome</u> and has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an employee's work performance or creating 13 14 a work environment that is intimidating, hostile, offensive or coercive 15 <u>to a reasonable person.</u>

16 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall apply to conduct 17 that occurs on and after such effective date.
