AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to providing domestic violence victims or crime victims with supervision while taking depositions

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as 2 the "Lydia Peikon Cotz act".

- 3 § 2. Section 3104 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by 4 adding a new subdivision (f) to read as follows:
- (f) Whenever a party is protected by an order of protection issued under section eight hundred forty-two of the family court act or a protective order issued under subdivision one of section 530.12 of the criminal procedure law, upon application, the court shall provide a secure location within the courthouse, and a court officer, for taking the deposition of either the party or the opposing party.
 - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
