AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to the central pine barrens area and the core preservation area

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivisions 10 and 11 of section 57-0107 of the environ-
2 mental conservation law, as amended by chapter 267 of the laws of 2015,
3 are amended to read as follows:

4 10. "Central Pine Barrens area" shall mean the contiguous area as
5 described and bounded as follows:

6 Beginning at a point where the southerly side of Route 25A intersects
7 the easterly side of Miller Place Road; thence southward along the east-
8 erly boundary of Miller Place Road to Helme Avenue; thence southward
9 along the easterly boundary of Helme Avenue to Miller Place-Middle
10 Island Road; thence southward along the easterly boundary of Miller
11 Place-Middle Island Road to Whiskey Road; thence westward along the
12 southerly boundary of Whiskey Road to Mount Sinai-Coram Road; thence
13 southward along the easterly boundary of Mount Sinai-Coram Road to
14 Middle Country Road (Route 25); thence westward along the southerly
15 boundary of Route 25 to Patchogue-Mount Sinai Road (County Route 83);
16 thence southward along the easterly boundary of County Route 83 to Bicy-
17 cle Path Drive; thence southeastward along the easterly side of Bicycle
18 Path Drive to Mt. McKinley Avenue; thence southward along the easterly
19 boundary of Mt. McKinley Avenue to Granny Road; thence northeastward
20 along the northerly boundary of Granny Road to Port Jefferson-Patchogue
21 Road (Route 112); thence southward along the easterly boundary of Route
22 112 to Horse Block Road (County Route 16); thence eastward along the
23 northerly boundary of County Route 16 to Maine Avenue; thence northward
24 along the westerly boundary of Maine Avenue to Fire Avenue; thence east-
25 ward along the northerly boundary of Fire Avenue to John Roe Smith
26 Avenue; thence southward along the easterly boundary of John Roe Smith
27 Avenue to Jeff Street; thence eastward along the northerly boundary of
28 Jeff Street to Hagerman Avenue; thence southward along the easterly

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1 boundary of Hagerman Avenue to the Long Island Expressway (Route 495);
2 thence eastward along the northerly boundary of Route 495 to the westerly
3 side of Yaphank Avenue (County Road 21); thence southward along the
4 westerly side of Yaphank Avenue to the south side of the Long Island
5 Expressway (Route 495); thence eastward along the southerly side of the
6 Long Island Expressway (Route 495) to the easterly side of Yaphank
7 Avenue; thence southward along the easterly side of Yaphank Avenue,
8 crossing Sunrise Highway (Route 27) to the south side of Montauk Highway
9 (County Road 80); thence southwestward along the south side of Montauk
10 Highway (County Road 80) to South Country Road; thence southward along
11 the easterly side of South Country Road to Fireplace Neck Road; thence
12 southward along the easterly side of Fireplace Neck Road to Beaver Dam
13 Road; thence eastward along the northerly side of Beaver Dam Road to the
14 westerly boundary of the Carmans River and the lands owned by the United
15 States known as Wertheim National Wildlife Refuge (the "Refuge"); thence
16 generally westerly and southerly to the waters of Bellport Bay; thence
17 generally easterly across the Bay and northerly along the easterly boundary
18 of the Refuge, including all lands currently part of the Refuge and
19 any lands which may become part of the Refuge in the future, to the east
20 side of the southern terminus of Smith Road; thence northward along the
21 easterly side of Smith Road to the southwesterly corner of the property
22 identified as District 200, Section 974.50, Block 1, Lot 11; thence
23 eastward, northward and westward in a counter-clockwise direction along
24 the southern, eastern and northern boundaries of that property to the
25 easterly side of Smith Road; thence northward along the east side of
26 Smith Road to Merrick Road; thence northeasterly along the northerly
27 side of Merrick Road to the easterly side of Surrey Circle and the
28 southwest corner of the property identified as District 200, Section
29 880, Block 3, Lot 58.1; running thence easterly along the southerly side
30 of said lot to the west side of William Floyd Parkway (County Road 46);
31 thence northerly along the westerly side of William Floyd Parkway (County
32 Road 46), crossing Route 27, to the Long Island Railroad (LIRR);
33 thence eastward along the northerly boundary of the Long Island Railroad
34 tracks 7,500 feet; thence southward 500 feet; thence eastward 525
35 feet to the intersection of North Street and Manor-Yaphank Road; thence
36 southward along the easterly boundary of Manor-Yaphank Road to Moriches-
37 Middle Island Road; thence eastward along the northerly boundary of
38 Moriches-Middle Island Road to a point due north of the easterly boundary
39 of Cranford Boulevard; thence southward across Moriches-Middle Island
40 Road and along the easterly boundary of Cranford Boulevard to the southwestern
41 corner of the property identified as District 200, Section 645,
42 Block 3, Lot 29.1; thence southeastward along the southerly boundary of
43 said property to its intersection with property identified as District
44 200, Section 712, Block 9, Lot 1; thence generally southward along the
45 westerly boundary of said property to its intersection with the northerly
46 side of the eastward extension of Grove Drive; thence southward
47 crossing Grove Drive to its south side; thence westward along the southerly
48 boundary of the Grove Drive road extension to the northwestern
49 corner of the property identified as District 200, Section 749, Block 3,
50 Lot 41.1; and comprised of parcels owned by the county of Suffolk and
51 the town of Brookhaven; thence southward to the southwestern corner of
52 property identified as District 200, Section 749, Block 3, Lot 43;
53 thence eastward along the southerly boundary of said property to the
54 west side of Lambert Avenue; thence crossing Lambert Avenue to its easterly
55 side; thence southward along the easterly boundary of Lambert
56 Avenue to the northerly boundary of the Sunrise Highway Service Road;

1 thence northeastward along the northerly boundary of the Sunrise Highway
2 Service Road to Barnes Road; thence northward along the westerly bounda-
3 ry of Barnes Road to the northeastern corner of property identified as
4 District 200, Section 750, Block 3, Lot 40.2; thence westward along the
5 northerly boundary of said property to the property identified as
6 District 200, Section 713, Block 1, Lot 2; thence westward along the
7 northerly boundary of property identified as District 200, Section 713,
8 Block 1, Lot 1; thence northward along the westerly side of Weeks Avenue
9 to the northeastern corner of property identified as District 200,
10 Section 713, Block 3, Lot 1; thence westward along the northerly bounda-
11 ry of said property to Michigan Avenue; thence northward along the east-
12 erly boundary of Michigan Ave to Moriches-Middle Island Road; thence
13 eastward along the northerly boundary of Moriches-Middle Island Road to
14 Sunrise Highway (Route 27); thence eastward along the northerly boundary
15 of Route 27 to an old railroad grade (unpaved); thence southeastward
16 along the northerly boundary of the old railroad grade (unpaved) to Old
17 County Road (Route 71); thence eastward along the northerly boundary of
18 Route 71 to the Long Island Rail Road tracks; thence eastward along the
19 northerly boundary of the Long Island Rail Road tracks to Montauk High-
20 way; thence eastward along the northerly boundary of Montauk Highway to
21 Route 24; thence northward along the westerly boundary of Route 24 to
22 Sunrise Highway (Route 27); thence eastward along the northerly boundary
23 of Route 27 to Squiretown Road; thence northward along the westerly
24 boundary of Squiretown Road to Upper Red Creek Road; thence westward
25 along the southern boundary of Upper Red Creek to Lower Red Creek Road;
26 thence southward along the easterly boundary of Lower Red Creek Road to
27 Hubbard County Park; thence westward along the northern boundary of
28 Hubbard County Park to Riverhead-Hampton Bays Road (Route 24); thence
29 westward along the southerly boundary of Route 24 to Peconic Avenue;
30 thence northward along the westerly boundary of Peconic Avenue to the
31 Riverhead-Southampton border; thence westward along the Riverhead-South-
32 ampton border and the Riverhead-Brookhaven border to the Forge Road
33 Bridge; thence northward along the westerly boundary of the Forge Road
34 Bridge to Forge Road; thence northwestward along the westerly boundary
35 of Forge Road to the railroad tracks; thence northward along the wester-
36 ly boundary of Forge Road (unpaved) to the intersection of Route 25 and
37 River Road; thence westward along the southerly boundary of River Road
38 to Edwards Avenue; thence northward along the westerly boundary of
39 Edwards Avenue 3,800 feet; thence westward 4,400 feet to an unnamed,
40 unpaved road; thence northward along the westerly boundary of the
41 unnamed, unpaved road 150 feet; thence westward and northwestward along
42 the eastern boundary of the United States Navy/Grumman Aerospace Corpo-
43 ration property (as of 1982) up to its intersection with Middle Country
44 Road (Route 25); thence westward along the southerly boundary of Route
45 25 to the intersection of Route 25 and 25A; thence northeastward, west-
46 ward, and southwestward along the eastern and northern boundary of the
47 United States Navy/Grumman Aerospace Corporation (as of 1982) and
48 located immediately east of Route 25A, to its intersection with Route
49 25A; thence westward along the southerly boundary of Route 25A to a
50 point due south of the southeast corner of the parcel identified as
51 District 200, Section 128, Block 1, lot 3.1; thence northeastward,
52 northward and westward along the southerly, easterly and northerly sides
53 of the parcel identified as District 200, section 128, Block 1, lot 1 to
54 the southeast corner of the parcel identified as District 200, Section
55 82, Block 1, Lot 5.2; thence northward along the east side of this
56 parcel to North Country Road; thence northward crossing North Country

Road to its northerly side; thence eastward along the northerly side of North Country Road to the Brookhaven Town-Riverhead Town line; thence in a generally northwestward direction along said town line to a point in Wading River Creek with the coordinates 40.96225 latitude and -72.863633 longitude; thence westward a distance of approximately 90 feet to the easterly side of LILCO Road; thence southward along LILCO Road to its intersection with the north side of North Country Road; thence westward along the north side of North Country Road to the southeast corner of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 39, Block 1, Lot 2; thence in a northward and westward direction along the easterly and northerly sides of said parcel to its northwest corner; thence northward along the westerly boundary of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 83, Block 1, Lot 1.4 to its northwest corner; and thence continuing in a westward direction along the northerly side of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 39, Block 1, Lot 1.2 and the southerly extent of Long Island Sound to the northwest corner of the property identified as District 200, Section 39, Block 1, Lot 1.2; thence southward along the westerly boundary of said property to North Country Road; thence west along the southerly boundary of North Country Road to the northwestern corner of property identified as District 200, Section 82, Block 1, Lot 1.1; thence south along the westerly boundary of said property and the westerly boundary of the property identified as District 200, Section 82, Block 1, Lot 1.2 to the northwest corner of property identified as District 200, Section 82, Block 1, Lot 5.1; thence southward along the westerly boundary of said property to the northeast corner of the property identified as District 200, Section 105, Block 3, Lot 5, thence southward along the easterly boundary of said property to the north side of Route 25A; thence southward crossing Route 25A to its south side; thence westward along the southerly boundary of Route 25A to the point or place of beginning, and excluding ~~one~~ two distinct ~~area~~ areas described as follows: The first area defined as beginning at a point where the westerly side of William Floyd Parkway (County Road 46) meets northerly side of the Long Island Railroad (LIRR); thence westward along the northerly side of the LIRR to Moriches-Middle Island Road; thence generally northwestward along the northerly side of Moriches-Middle Island Road to the southerly side of Long Island Expressway (Route 495); thence eastward along the southerly side of the Long Island Expressway (Route 495) to the westerly side of William Floyd Parkway (County Road 46); thence southward along the westerly side of William Floyd Parkway (County Road 46) and containing the subdivision known as RB Industrial Park, to the point or place of beginning and the second area defined as the property described as District 200, Section 39, Block 1, Lot 1.1.

11. "Core preservation area" shall mean the core preservation area of the Central Pine Barrens area which comprise the largest intact areas of undeveloped pine barrens as described and bounded as follows:

Beginning at a point where the northwestern corner of the New York State Rocky Point Natural Resource Management Area (the "NYS Rocky Point Land") intersects the southerly side of NYS Route 25A; thence generally southward and eastward along the generally westerly and southerly boundaries of the NYS Rocky Point Land (including the Currans Road Pond State Wildlife Management Area, all adjacent or contiguous undeveloped Town of Brookhaven parks, preserves, open space areas, or reserved areas, and the crossings of the undeveloped Suffolk County property known as the Port Jefferson - Westhampton road right of way, Whiskey Road, County Route 21, and Currans Road), and including those properties identified

1 as District 200, Section 346, Block 1, Lots 3 and 4, to the point where
2 the NYS Rocky Point Land meets the northerly side of NYS Route 25
3 (Middle Country Road); thence eastward along the northerly boundary of
4 NYS Route 25 to the southeastern corner of that property west of Wood-
5 lots Road which is identified as District 200, Section 349, Block 2, Lot
6 1.3; thence northward along the easterly boundary of that property to
7 the Suffolk County Pine Trail Nature Preserve; thence eastward and
8 southeastward along the southerly boundary of the Suffolk County Pine
9 Trail Nature Preserve where the Preserve is adjacent to developed
10 parcels or parcels in agricultural or horticultural use, or along a line
11 parallel to, and 100 (one hundred) feet south of, the Preserve where the
12 Preserve is adjacent to parcels which are undeveloped as of June 1,
13 1993, to County Route 46; thence southward along the easterly boundary
14 of County Route 46 to NYS Route 25; thence eastward along the southerly
15 boundary of NYS Route 25 to the Suffolk County Pine Trail Nature
16 Preserve; thence southward along the westerly boundary of the Suffolk
17 County Pine Trail Nature Preserve where the Preserve is adjacent to
18 developed parcels, or along a line parallel to, and 100 (one hundred)
19 feet west of, the Preserve where the Preserve is adjacent to parcels
20 which are undeveloped as of June 1, 1993, to the northern boundary of
21 the United States land known as Brookhaven National Laboratory; thence
22 generally westward along the northerly boundary of Brookhaven National
23 Laboratory to County Route 46 (William Floyd Parkway); thence generally
24 northwestward on a straight line to the intersection of Sally Lane and
25 Pond Lane; thence westward along the southerly side of Pond Lane to Ruth
26 Lane; thence northward along the westerly side of Ruth Lane to NYS Route
27 25; thence westward along the northerly side of NYS Route 25 to the
28 southeast corner of the NYS Middle Island State Game Farm and Environ-
29 mental Education Center; thence northward, westward, and southward along
30 the easterly, northerly, and westerly boundaries of the NYS Middle
31 Island State Game Farm and Environmental Education Center to NYS Route
32 25; thence westward along the southerly side of NYS Route 25, excluding
33 all parcels abutting that road which are developed as of June 1, 1993,
34 to Giant Oak Road; thence southward along the easterly side of Giant Oak
35 Road to Medford Road; thence southwestward along the southeasterly side
36 of Medford Road crossing to the west side of Smith Road; thence southerly
37 along the westerly side of Smith Road to the southeast corner of
38 District 200, Section 406, Block 1, Lot 6; thence westward and northward
39 along the southerly and westerly sides of said parcel to the southerly
40 side of the developed lands known as Strathmore Ridge; thence westward,
41 northward and eastward along the southerly, westerly and northerly sides
42 of the developed lands known as Strathmore Ridge to the westerly side of
43 Smith Road; thence northerly along the westerly side of Smith Road to
44 the southerly side of NYS Route 25; thence westerly along the southerly
45 side of NYS Route 25, to the northwestern corner of that property which
46 is identified as District 200, Section 406, Block 1, Lot 4.3; thence
47 southerly along the westerly boundary of that property and continuing
48 southward along the westerly sides of the properties identified as
49 District 200, Section 406, Block 1, Lot 4.6; District 200, Section 406,
50 Block 1, Lot 4.4 and District 200, Section 504, Block 1, Lot 2 to the
51 southerly side of Longwood Road; thence eastward along the southerly
52 side of Longwood Road to the northwest corner of the property identified
53 as District 200, Section 504, Block 1, Lot 7.2; thence southward and
54 westward along the generally westerly boundary of that parcel to the
55 eastern end of Rugby Lane (also known as Rugby Avenue or Rugby Road), a
56 paper street shown on Suffolk County tax maps District 200, Sections

1 500, 502, and 503; thence westward along the northerly boundary of Rugby
2 Lane, across County Route 21, to the westerly boundary of County Route
3 21 (Yaphank - Middle Island Road); thence southward along the westerly
4 boundary of County Route 21 to the northeastern corner of the parcel
5 identified as District 200, Section 529, Block 1, Lot 28, and which is
6 coterminous with the southerly boundaries of the parcels located on the
7 south side of Rustic Lane; thence westward along the northerly boundary
8 of that parcel to the southwest corner of the parcel identified as
9 District 200, Section 528, Block 5, Lot 2; thence northward along a
10 portion of the easterly boundary of the Carmans River, which comprises
11 the easterly boundary of the parcel identified as District 200, Section
12 528, Block 5, Lot 1, to its intersection with the southern boundary of
13 the Suffolk County Nature Preserve parcel identified as District 200,
14 Section 500, Block 1, Lot 1.4; thence eastward along the southern bound-
15 ary of that parcel to the southeast corner of that parcel; thence north-
16 ward along the easterly boundary of that Suffolk County Nature Preserve
17 parcel to the southeast corner of the Suffolk County Nature Preserve
18 parcel identified as District 200, Section 500, Block 1, Lot 3.1, thence
19 generally northward along the easterly boundary of that parcel to the
20 north side of East Bartlett Road; thence easterly along the north side
21 of East Bartlett Road to the east side of County Road 21; thence south-
22 erly along the east side of County Road 21 to the southwest corner of
23 District 200, Section 501, Block 1, Lot 2.1; thence easterly and north-
24 erly along the southern and eastern sides of that property and northward
25 along the easterly side of District 0200, 50100, Block 0100, Lot 002002
26 and across to the north side of Longwood Road; thence westerly along the
27 north side of Longwood Road to the southeast corner of District 200,
28 Section 482, Block 1, Lot 3.1; thence northward and eastward along the
29 easterly and southerly boundaries of that parcel to the northwest corner
30 of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 483, Block 2, Lot 1.4;
31 thence eastward along the southerly property boundary of the parcel
32 identified as District 200, Section 482, Block 1, Lot 4 to the southeast
33 corner of that parcel; thence northward along the easterly boundary of
34 that parcel to the northeast corner of that parcel; thence eastward and
35 northward along the southerly and easterly boundaries of the parcel
36 identified as District 200, Section 456, Block 2, Lot 4 to the northeast
37 corner of that parcel; thence generally northerly and westerly along the
38 easterly and northerly boundary of Prosser Pines County Nature Preserve
39 to County Road 21; thence westward (directly across County Route 21)
40 along the southerly boundary of the property identified as District 200,
41 Section 434, Block 1, Lot 12.1, to the southwest corner of the property
42 identified as District 200, Section 434, Block 1, Lot 14.3, adjacent to
43 the eastern side of Cathedral Pines County Park; thence northward along
44 the eastern boundary of Cathedral Pines County Park to the southeast
45 corner of the property identified as District 200, Section 402, Block 1,
46 Lot 23.1, thence continuing northward along the easterly boundary of
47 that property to the southerly side of Lafayette Road; thence westward
48 along the southerly side of Lafayette Road to the eastern boundary of
49 the property identified as District 200, Section 402, Block 1, Lot 24.7;
50 thence generally in a counter-clockwise direction along the easterly,
51 northerly, westerly and northerly boundaries of that property to the
52 easterly boundary of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 402,
53 Block 1, Lot 19.2; thence northerly along the easterly side of said lot
54 to the southeast corner of the property identified as District 200,
55 Section 402, Block 1, Lot 20, thence westward and northward along the
56 southerly and westerly sides of that property to the southerly side of

1 NYS Route 25; thence westward along the southerly boundary of NYS Route
2 25 to the northwestern corner of the parcel identified as District 200,
3 Section 402, Block 1, Lot 16.4; thence generally southward along the
4 westerly boundary of that parcel to the northerly boundary of the parcel
5 identified as District 200, Section 454, Block 1, Lot 9.1; thence west-
6 ward along the northerly boundary of that parcel to East Bartlett Road;
7 thence southward along the easterly boundary of East Bartlett Road to
8 its intersection with Ashton Road; thence westward to the northeastern
9 corner of the old filed map shown on District 200, Section 499; thence
10 westward and southward along the northerly and westerly boundaries of
11 the old filed map shown on Suffolk County tax maps District 200,
12 Sections 498, 499, and 527 to Hillcrest Road; thence eastward along the
13 southerly boundary of Hillcrest Road to Ashton Road; thence southward
14 along the easterly side of Ashton Road to Granny Road; thence eastward
15 along the southerly side of Granny Road to the northwesterly corner of
16 District 200, Section 547, Block 1, Lot 18.1; thence generally south-
17 ward, westward, southward, eastward and northward in a counter-clockwise
18 direction along the western, northern, southern and eastern boundaries
19 of said parcel to the southeast corner of the parcel identified as
20 District 200, Section 548, Block 1, Lot 3; thence northward along the
21 easterly boundary of that parcel to its northeast corner; thence gener-
22 ally northward, northeastward and eastward along the westerly, northwes-
23 terly and northerly sides of German Boulevard to its intersection with
24 the northeasterly side of Lakeview Boulevard; thence southeastward along
25 the northeasterly side of Lakeview Boulevard to the westerly boundary of
26 the parcel identified as District 200, Section 611, Block 1, Lot 5;
27 thence northward along the westerly boundary of that parcel to its
28 northwest corner; thence southward along the westerly boundary of the
29 parcel identified as District 200, Section 579, Block 3, Lot 1, compris-
30 ing part of the western bank of the Carmans River also known as Upper
31 Lake, to the northerly side of Mill Road, also known as County Route
32 101; thence eastward along the northerly side of Mill Road to the north-
33 east corner of the parcel identified as District 200, Section 579, Block
34 3, Lot 19; thence westerly along the northerly boundary of that parcel
35 to the eastern boundary of the parcel identified as District 200,
36 Section 579, Block 3, Lot 1; thence northward along the easterly side of
37 that parcel, comprising part of the eastern bank of the Carmans River
38 also known as Upper Lake, to the southwest corner of the parcel identi-
39 fied as District 200, Section 548, Block 2, Lot 5.1; thence eastward
40 along the southern boundary of that parcel to its southeast corner;
41 thence eastward across County Route 21 to its easterly side; thence
42 northward along the easterly boundary of County Route 21 to the south-
43 west corner of the Suffolk County Nature Preserve parcel known as
44 Warbler Woods and identified as District 200, Section 551, Block 1, Lot
45 4; thence generally eastward along the southerly boundary of the Warbler
46 Woods parcel and then southward along the westerly boundary of an exten-
47 sion of that parcel's southerly boundary to the southeast corner of the
48 southern terminus of Harold Road; thence generally westward, southward
49 and westward in a counter-clockwise direction along the northerly,
50 westerly, northerly and westerly boundaries of the Suffolk County Nature
51 Preserve parcel known as Fox Lair, and identified as District 200,
52 Section 580, Block 3, Lot 24.2, to the northwest corner of the parcel
53 Suffolk County Water Authority parcel identified as District 200,
54 Section 580, Block 3, Lot 24.6; thence southward, eastward and southward
55 along the westerly boundary and southerly boundaries of that Suffolk
56 County Water Authority parcel to Main Street; thence eastward along the

1 north side of Main Street to the southeast corner of said Suffolk County
2 Water Authority parcel to its southeast corner; thence northward along
3 the easterly boundary of that parcel to the southwest property boundary
4 of the Suffolk County Nature Preserve parcel known as Fox Lair and iden-
5 tified as District 200, Section 580, Block 3, Lot 24.2, thence generally
6 eastward, southward, eastward, northward and eastward along the souther-
7 ly boundaries of said parcel and eastward along the southerly boundary
8 of the Suffolk County Nature Preserve parcel identified as District 200,
9 Section 583, Block 1, Lot 4.1, to the west side of the unimproved north-
10 south oriented road known variously as Smith Road, Longwood Road and
11 Private Road; thence southward along the westerly boundary of Smith Road
12 to the north side of the Long Island Expressway; thence westward along
13 the northerly boundary of the Long Island Expressway to the south side
14 of Main Street in Yaphank; thence westward along the southerly boundary
15 of Main Street in Yaphank to the westernmost extent along Main Street of
16 the Southaven County Park boundary; thence westward across County Road

13 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-
14 ing the date on which it shall have become a law provided that if the
15 provisions of this act establishing a new description and boundaries of
16 the Central Pine Barrens Area or the core preservation area removed or
17 excludes any of the lands of the Central Pine Barrens Area or the core
18 preservation area as such lands are described and bounded in chapter 267
19 of the laws of 2015, and/or protections established and/or provided by
20 such act, this act shall be deemed repealed and of no force and effect
21 and chapter 267 of the laws of 2015 shall remain in full force and
22 effect. The state legislature shall notify the legislative bill draft-
23 ing commission of any such decrease and resulting repeal in order that
24 the commission may maintain an accurate and timely effective data base
25 of the official text of the laws of the state of New York in furtherance
26 of effectuating the provisions of section 44 of the legislative law and
27 section 70-b of the public officers law.
