AN ACT to amend part E of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017 relating to the effective date of certain provisions thereof, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 5544 and A. 7216, in relation to the effectiveness thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Section 7 of part E of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017,
2 amending the social services law relating to fiscal intermediary certification under the consumer directed personal assistance program, as
3 amended by a chapter of the laws of 2017, amending part E of chapter 57
4 of the laws of 2017 relating to the effective date of certain provisions
5 thereof, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 5544 and A. 7216,
6 is amended to read as follows:

7 § 7. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to
8 have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2017; except
9 that section one of this act shall take effect on the first of January
10 after it shall have become a law; provided that prior to that date, the
11 commissioner of health shall [~~make regulations and~~] take [~~other~~] actions
12 reasonably necessary to implement subdivisions 4-a and 4-b of section
13 365-f of the social services law, as added by section one of this act,
14 on that date; and provided further that any entity operating as a fiscal
15 intermediary prior to this act becoming a law may continue to do so [~~for~~
16 ~~one year after this act takes effect~~] until January 31, 2018, and may
17 continue to do so after that time only upon obtaining authorization
18 under this act.

19 § 2. This act shall take effect on the same date and in the same
20 manner as a chapter of the laws of 2017, amending part E of chapter 57
21 of the laws of 2017 relating to the effective date of certain provisions
22 thereof, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 5544 and A. 7216,
23 takes effect.
