AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to the removal of all police markings, patterns and affixed lights from a vehicle prior to decommissioning and auction

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 375 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by 2 adding a new subdivision 52 to read as follows:
- 52. (a) Any police vehicle purchased by the state, a public authority, or any municipality must have all police markings, patterns and affixed lights removed prior to the decommissioning and auction of such vehicle.
- 6 (b) The superintendent or chief of police, or other person responsible
 7 for the supervision and maintenance of a fleet of police vehicles, shall
 8 cause any police vehicle that is scheduled to be decommissioned and
 9 auctioned to have all police markings, patterns and affixed lights
 10 removed.
- 11 (c) The commissioner of the division of criminal justice services, in 12 consultation with the commissioner of motor vehicles, shall promulgate 13 rules and regulations determining the specifications that must be met to 14 consider any vehicle ready for decommissioning and auction.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the sixtieth day after it shall 16 have become a law; provided, however, that effective immediately, the 17 addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary 18 for the implementation of this act on its effective date is authorized 19 and directed to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
