- AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to the qualifications for holding the offices of assistant district attorney and assistant public defender in the county of Chenango

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding 1 2 two new subdivisions 67 and 68 to read as follows: 3 67. In the county of Chenango, the provisions of this section requir-4 ing a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal 5 corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall б not prevent a person from holding the office of assistant district 7 8 attorney of the county of Chenango, provided that such person resides in 9 Chenango county or an adjoining county within the state of New York; provided, however that any person performing such functions or holding 10 11 the office of assistant district attorney in any other county shall be a resident of such county unless otherwise provided by law. The provisions 12 13 of this subdivision shall not apply to any person holding the office of 14 first assistant district attorney, the holder of which would assume the 15 duties of the district attorney upon the district attorney's absence from the county or upon the district attorney's inability to perform his 16 17 <u>or her duties.</u> 18 68. In the county of Chenango, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal 19 20 corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within 21 which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall 22 not prevent a person from holding the office of assistant public defender of the county of Chenango, provided that such person resides in 23 24 Chenango county or an adjoining county within the state of New York; 25 provided, however that any person performing such functions or holding 26 the office of assistant public defender in any other county shall be a
