AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to clinical laboratory supervision

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The public health law is amended by adding a new section 1 576-d to read as follows:

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§ 576-d. Clinical laboratory supervision. 1. (a) Each clinical labora-4 tory shall have one or more supervisors who shall, under the general 5 direction of the director, supervise the technical personnel and report-6 ing of findings, perform tests requiring special scientific skills, and, in the absence of the director, be responsible for the proper performance of all laboratory procedures.

- (b) A director who qualifies as provided in regulations promulgated 9 10 pursuant to section five hundred seventy-three of this title shall also 11 be deemed qualified as a supervisor.
- (c) Depending upon the size and functions of the clinical laboratory, 12 13 the department may authorize the director to also serve as the supervisor of such laboratory. 14
- (d) The supervisor shall be on the clinical laboratory premises or 15 16 available by phone or synchronous two-way electronic audio visual commu-17 nications within thirty minutes during all hours in which tests are performed; provided, that if the supervisor is not on the laboratory 18 19 premises and the person performing the test qualifies as a medical technologist as provided in regulations promulgated pursuant to sections 20 21 five hundred seventy-four and five hundred seventy-six of this title, 22 and thirty-one hundred twenty-one of this chapter, the results of his or her work are reviewed by the supervisor or director during his or her 24 next duty period, and a record is maintained to reflect the actual 25 review.
- (e) An individual who qualifies as a supervisor as provided in regu-26 27 lations promulgated pursuant to sections five hundred seventy-four and 28 five hundred seventy-six of this title, and thirty-one hundred twenty-

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one of this chapter shall supervise technical personnel in the specialty 1 2 of cytology only.

- 2. (a) For the purposes of this subdivision, "clinical laboratory improvement amendments" means the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment of 1988, Public Law 100-578, as amended and any requlations or guidance issued thereunder.
- (b) Every clinical supervisor shall meet one of the following requirements:
- (i) the supervisor is a physician licensed to practice medicine or osteopathy in the state, or who has earned a doctoral degree in a chemical, physical or biological science from an accredited institution. "Accredited", as used in this paragraph, refers to accreditation by a nationally recognized accrediting agency or association, as determined 14 by the United States commissioner of education. Such supervisor shall, subsequent to graduation, have had at least the required number of years' experience in one of the laboratory specialties in a clinical laboratory or blood bank having a director at the doctoral level, as provided for and consistent with the clinical laboratory improvement amendments. The clinical laboratory or blood bank shall be part of a hospital, health department, university, medical research institution, 20 21 or other institution which provides equivalent training;
 - (ii) the supervisor holds a degree of master of arts or master of science in a chemical, physical or biological science from an accredited institution and, subsequent to graduation, has had at least the required number of years spent working in the designated laboratory specialty in a clinical laboratory having a director at the doctoral level, as provided for and consistent with the clinical laboratory improvement amendments. The clinical laboratory or blood bank shall be part of a hospital, health department, university, medical research institution or other institution which provides equivalent training;
 - (iii) the supervisor is qualified as a medical technologist as provided in regulations promulgated pursuant to sections five hundred seventy-four and five hundred seventy-six of this title, and thirty-one hundred twenty-one of this chapter and has had at least the required number of years of pertinent clinical laboratory experience, including training, subsequent to qualifying, spent working in a clinical laboratory having a director at the doctoral level, as provided for and consistent with the clinical laboratory improvement amendments. The clinical laboratory or blood bank shall be part of a hospital, university, health department, medical research institution or other institution which provides equivalent training; or
 - (iv) the supervisor is qualified as a cytotechnologist as provided in regulations promulgated pursuant to sections five hundred seventy-four and five hundred seventy-six of this title, and thirty-one hundred twenty-one of this chapter and subsequent to qualifying, has had at least the required number of years of pertinent clinical laboratory experience, including training, in cytotechnology in a laboratory having a doctoral level director qualified in cytopathology, as provided for and consistent with the clinical laboratory improvement amendments. The clinical laboratory shall be part of a hospital, health department, university, medical research institution, or other institution which provides equivalent training.
- 53 (c) With respect to individuals first qualifying prior to April first, 54 nineteen hundred seventy-two, an exception to the requirements of subparagraph (i), (ii) or (iii) of paragraph (b) of this subdivision may 55 56 be made if:

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(i) the supervisor was performing the duties of a clinical laboratory supervisor at any time between July first, nineteen hundred sixty-one and September first, nineteen hundred seventy-one;

- (ii) the supervisor has had at least fifteen years of pertinent clinical laboratory experience prior to September first, nineteen hundred seventy-one; provided, that, a minimum of thirty semester hours of credit toward a bachelor's degree in a chemical, physical or biological science, or thirty semester hours in an approved school of medical technology shall reduce the required years of experience by two years, with any additional hours further reducing the required years of experience at the rate of fifteen hours for one year; and
- 12 <u>(iii) he or she has performed the duties of a supervisor for at least</u>
 13 <u>two years during the qualifying fifteen years in:</u>
- 14 <u>(A) a clinical laboratory having a director at the doctoral level of a</u>
 15 <u>hospital, university, health department or medical research institution;</u>
 16 <u>or</u>
- 17 (B) in a laboratory approved under the Medicare supplementary medical
 18 insurance program, provided also, that where qualifying years in a clin19 ical laboratory described in clause (A) of this subparagraph are
 20 obtained after January thirtieth, nineteen hundred sixty-nine, such
 21 laboratory meets applicable conditions under the Medicare health insur22 ance program, or under the regulations issued pursuant to the federal
 23 Clinical Laboratories Improvement Act of 1967.
 - § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
